BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP MINISTRY

In our Bible Study "The Bible and the Virgin Mary", we learned how our Blessed Mother Mary's visit to Elizabeth parallels David's bringing of the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem.
