BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP MINISTRY

In our Bible Study "The Bible and the Virgin Mary", we learned how our Blessed Mother Mary's visit to Elizabeth parallels David's bringing of the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem. The Ark of the Covenant represented God's presence among his people. David "leaped and danced" when he saw the Ark arrive. The child in Elizabeth's womb leaped when Mary arrived at her cousin's home. Both David and Elizabeth cried out in a loud voice, with praise, joy and awe at having God's presence manifested before them.

Later in Israel's history the prophet Jeremiah hid the Ark of the Covenant, as he was directed in a vision from God. This was to protect the Ark from the impending Assyrian invasion. Jeremiah also prophesied that the Ark would not be revealed until "God gathered his people again" in the new covenant. The Ark next "appears" in sacred scripture in the Book of Revelation and is described as "a woman clothed with the sun"...who gives birth to the eventual "ruler of all nations". The new Ark is Our Blessed Mother! God Bless.
