On January 17, 2018 The Government of Canada announced the appointment of a human rights ombudsperson that will oversee Canadian mining, oil and gas operations around the world after ten years of campaigning on this issue. The Minister of International Trade Francois-Philippe Champagne announced that the ombudsperson will have the power to investigate complaints concerning the overseas operations of Canadian companies and will issue public findings on allegations of harm.
