OLQW will Ring the Bells for Peace



On November 11, at the going down of the sun, communities across Canada will mark the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War with the ringing of 100 bells. The ringing of bells emulates the moment in 1918 when church bells across Europe tolled as four years of war had come to an end. At sunset on November 11, the bells will ring at Parliament Hill, city halls, places of worship, military bases, Naval vessels and at ceremonies across the country to honour Canada's Veterans and commemorate the end of the First World War. Our Lady Queen of the World Youth and Knights of Columbus will lead us in this ceremony. **All parishioners are welcome to gather in the narthex to participate.** When you hear the bells toll on November 11, take a moment to pause and remember all those who served and sacrificed.
