#### **BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM**

In our study we learn about two of the greatest kings in Israel's history -David and Solomon. David established Jerusalem as Israel's

royal city. He also made it a holy city by bringing the Ark of the Covenant (a symbol of God's presence) to Jerusalem. Solomon (David's son) builds the magnificent temple there – a place for God to dwell among His people. This temple prefigures Jesus. Jesus, God's Son, who came down to live among His people is the "new" temple. Jesus says "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." (John 2:19) referring to his death and resurrection, the "temple" he speaks of is His body. After ascending into heaven and giving us the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, Jesus' body, the Church, becomes the temple where God is present among us. This is true of the Church as a whole and us as individuals. "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you" (1 Corinthians 3:16).
