### BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM



During Israel's difficult history which included division of their own nation, and pagan religious influences, oppression, slavery and exile by foreign nations, great prophets like Isaiah delivered a

message of hope. Hundreds of years later, Jesus declared himself to be this Messiah, when reading from the book of Isaiah, in the synagogue of his home town in Nazareth. Jesus said that God's Spirit was upon him and that God had anointed him to preach good news to the poor, release to captives, sight to the blind, comfort to the broken-hearted and to proclaim God's redemption to His people. (Lk 4:16-19; Isaiah 61:1-2). Many of the people did not believe Jesus, and rejected him. During Lent, as we walk through the desert of our own trials, Jesus asks us to accept him as our saviour and walk with him by sharing his cross and sufferings, so we may experience the Easter joy and healing of his resurrection.
