BIBLE STUDY



As we approach Easter we meditate on the passion of Jesus. We may find it difficult to understand the role we played in Jesus' death, considering we

were not alive at the time. When asked by the Roman governor to choose one prisoner to be released, the people chose Barabbas, a notorious criminal, over Jesus, the innocent one of God. The name "Barabbas" actually means "son of the father". We are all "sons" (or daughters) of God the Father. So, ultimately, Jesus died not just in Barabbas' place, but also in our place. "For our sake God made him (Jesus) to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God" (2 Corinthians 5:21). By taking on our human flesh in becoming man, Jesus also took our sin upon himself. When Jesus died on the cross, he ensured that our sin died with him. Then by rising from the dead, he gave us new life. Just as Jesus releases us from our sins, God expects us to release and forgive each other.
