TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL BYLAW **RE: FIRE ACCESS ROUTES**



Please be advised: Bylaw 1090.2.1 by the Chief Fire Official "The Fire & Emergency Services of the Town has the authority to designate a fire route on any municipal property and on any private roadway providing access to or egress from any structure or lands used for the accommodation

of the public or for the gathering or assembling of people. Every person who contravenes this designation is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act." Please do not park on any fire access route, here at the parish or at JV HighSchool. Fire route areas are marked with diagonal yellow lines and/or with signs such as this one.
