Please contact the priest one year in advance, as this is the requirement.

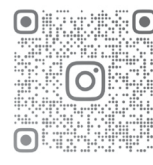

SUNDAY REFLECTION

The readings of the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary time help us to prepare for the solemnity of Christ, The King of the Universe. The Sacred Scripture poses a question; Where is this world headed? 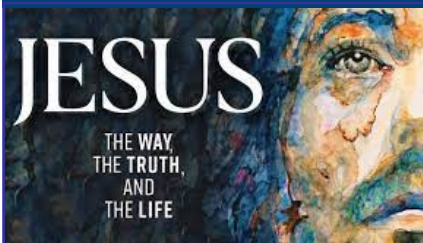
