Jubilee Year 2025



The Catholic Church worldwide is celebrating a special Jubilee Year in 2025. This has been a tradition dating back to the year 1300 when Pope Boniface VIII announced the first Jubilee, which is also referred to as a "Holy Year". The frequency has changed over time, with a Jubilee year originally celebrated every 100 years, later every 50 years and, more recently, every 25 years or at the request of the Holy Father.

The Jubilee Year includes many celebrations within the city of Rome and also local initiatives in dioceses around the world. The theme of the 2025 Jubilee is "**Pilgrims of Hope**".

In honour of this Jubilee Year of Hope, the Archdiocese of Toronto has designated some parishes as pilgrimage sites and invites all to plan a visit in the coming months.

There will be a special Jubilee Mass celebrated by Bishop John Boissonneau on Thursday January 30 at 7 pm at **St Mary's Parish in Barrie**. All are invited to attend. Confessions will be available before Mass.

There is a special Jubilee Mass to be celebrated by Cardinal Leo on Tuesday February 4 at 7 pm at **St Padre Pio's Parish in Woodbridge**. All are invited to attend. Confessions will be available before Mass.

Our Lady Queen of the World Parish is organizing a special Pilgrimage to celebrate the 2025 Jubilee Year which was recently launched in Rome by Pope Francis. This is a unique opportunity for the faithful to come and join us as **Pilgrims of Hope**, in keeping with the **theme of the 2025 Jubilee Year**.



We will visit the **Holy Doors at the Notre Dame Basilica in Quebec City**, which will be open for pilgrims to walk through, to gain special graces. These are the **only permanent Holy Doors outside of Europe**. We will also visit **St. Joseph's Oratory and Notre Dame Basilica in Montreal**, the **Franciscan Mission in Kahnawake** (the burial place of **St. Kateri Tekakwitha**); the **Church of St. Anne de Beaupré** on the **Côte de Beaupré**; and, **Notre Dame du Cap at Cap de la Madeleine**, the site of an approved miracle. Mark these dates in your calendars: **October 16 to 21**. Seats are **available to parishioners only up to February 2 and there after to the general public**.
