### Parish Jubilee Pilgrimage

Our Lady Queen of the World Parish is organizing a special Pilgrimage to celebrate the 2025 Jubilee Year which was recently launched in Rome by Pope Francis. This is a This is a 🥡 unique opportunity for the faithful to come and join us as Pilgrims of Hope,



in keeping with the theme of the 2025 Jubilee Year.

We will visit the Holy Doors at the Notre Dame Basilica in Quebec City, which will be open for pilgrims to walk through, to gain special graces. These are the only permanent Holy Doors outside of Europe. We will also visit St. Joseph's Oratory and Notre Dame Basilica in Montreal, the Franciscan Mission in Kahnawake (the burial place of St. Kateri Tekakwitha); the Church of St. Anne de Beaupré on the Côte de Beaupré; and, Notre Dame du Cap at Cap de la Madeleine, the site of an approved miracle. Mark these dates in your calendars: October 16 to 21. Seats are available to parishioners only up to February 2 and there **after to the general public**. If you are interested please pick up an information sheet from the church entrances, or the parish office, or visit www.olgw.com, for more information including itinerary, pricing and registration.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will celebrate Marriage Sunday on the weekend of February 8/9, 2025. As part of the Marriage Sunday celebrations, Bishop Ivan Camilleri will preside at a special Mass to honour married couples, with special recognition for those celebrating milestone wedding anniversaries (25th, 40th, 50th, 60th or 60+) in 2025. The Mass will take place at 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, February 9, 2025 at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond Street, Toronto). All married couples will have an opportunity to renew their marriage commitment during the Mass. Due to space restrictions those wishing to attend are invited to register online at www.archtoronto.org/marriage.


