#### Day of Prayer for Survivors of Abuse March 16, 2025

Pope Francis, the Bishops of Ontario and of all of Canada have asked that a Day of Prayer and Reflection for Victims and Survivors of Sex Abuse be observed for healing and to raise awareness. Here in the Archdiocese of Toronto the Second Sunday of Lent was chosen as an appropriate day to honour the wishes of the Holy Father, to express our remorse as a community, to pray for healing and assure safety in our parish communities.

This Sunday, we come face-to-face with the Transfigured glory of Our Lord, and by contrast acknowledge our need for healing and repentance as we strive to enter into the glory of the Lord. The Transfiguration is a reminder of the glory in which we are all called to enter at the end of this life, as well as a call to remedy those times when we fall short.

Our Lenten journey is a time of preparation for Easter when we will renew our Baptismal promises—to reject evil and embrace God, His Holiness, and His community. God calls us to address our sinfulness with humility, many of us consider performing penitential acts, and engaging in the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These serve as a remedy or means of realigning and nurturing our relationships with God and our neighbour.

Often, our penitential practices during Lent can be somewhat individualized; focusing on our personal relationship with God and our neighbour. But we are part of a larger community, we are part of the Catholic Church, and we need to recognize our need to approach God as a community of praise, worship and sacrifice, and also as a community afflicted by division and sorrow and in need of healing and forgiveness. Today in a special way we embody a communal penitential expression of sorrow, mourning, and humility for the sins of abuse.
