Welcome to Pope Leo XIV!

Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost of the United States was elected the **267**th **pope** on **May 8, 2025**. and pope on May 8, 2025, and stepped onto the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica as the new leader of the world's 1.4 billion Catholics. He's now known as **Pope Leo XIV**. Born in 1955



in Chicago, Illinois, he is the first US-born Pope in history. He is a past provincial prior for the Augustinian Province in Chicago and also previously served as a missionary in Peru (he was also Bishop of the diocese of Chiclayo, Peru since 2015). In his first words to the people, the new pope said, speaking in Italian, "We still have the sound in our ears of the weak voice of Pope Francis who was blessing Rome here. Giving his blessing to the world on that day of Easter Sunday. Allow me to continue that same blessing. God loves everyone. Evil will not prevail. We are all in the hands of God. So without fear, united, hand in hand, with God in ourselves, we go forward." He added: "We are disciples of Christ ... the world needs his light. Humanity needs him.' Leo then thanked his predecessor. May we all build bridges with dialogue ... so that we can all be one people in peace. Thank you, Pope Francis." Pope Leo XIV said he wants this message of peace to "enter your hearts, to reach your families and all people, wherever they are." He urged the faithful to "move forward, without fear, united, hand in hand with God and with each other." The new pope called for the light of Christ to serve "as the bridge" to God's love.




We collected 3,500 pounds of food and \$2,000 in cash donations. The Knights of Columbus also donated an additional \$2,000 to the Food Bank.
